

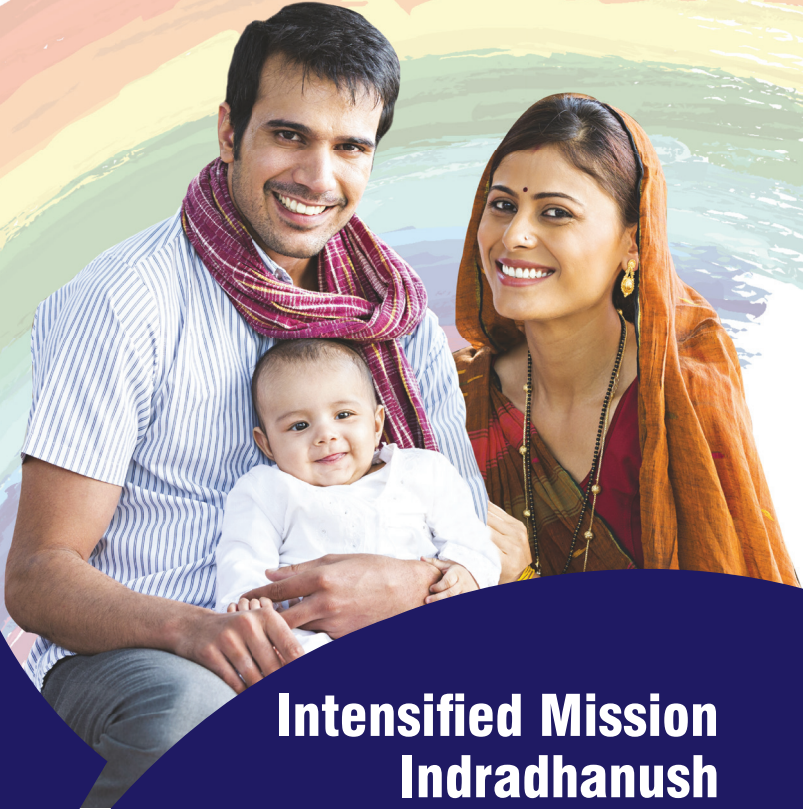

Intensified Mission Indradhanush

What Is Intensified Mission Indradhanush

- Intensified Mission Indradhanush is an opportunity to protect your child against 12 life threatening diseases through vaccines
- All these vaccines are provided free of cost to all children at all public health facilities under the Government's Universal Immunization programme
- These vaccines are safe, of high quality and are provided by trained ANMs
- Intensified Mission Indradhanush will begin from 7th October in your districts/Urban Cities

- Immunization drive will be for 7 days starting from 7th of every month from Oct 2017 to Jan 2018

What should you do

- Contact the ANM of the nearest health centre or ASHA of your area and get information about the location of the Intensified Mission Indradhanush session sites, dates and session that is accessible to you
- If you have a child under 2 years and has missed any vaccine do take him/her to your nearest vaccination site during the Intensified Mission Indradhanush week
- Remember to always go to the session site with the vaccination/Mother and Child Protection card
- If you have any worries, doubts and apprehensions about the vaccines, please discuss with the ASHA, ANM or health officer of your area/ locality

After vaccination

- After vaccination wait for at least 30 minutes to let the ANM complete your child's records and ensure the child is fine
- Do enquire about the next dose due for your child
- After vaccination contact your local ASHA/ ANM immediately if your child is unwell- either with pain, fever or any other symptoms
- Remember to keep the vaccination/Mother and Child Protection card safe. It is an important health need of your child
